



PARENTS AND GUARDIANS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be a responsible role model.
 - Familiarise yourself with the Eltham Panthers Netball Club's Purpose, Policies, Procedures and Codes of Conduct and abide by them.
 - Ensure your children arrive punctually for training and games.
 - Do not yell at, ridicule or scold players for making a mistake.
 - Recognise and applaud good play from all players, not just our own.
 - Do not participate in any type of aggressive behaviour, both physical and verbal, to umpires, officials, players or any other club members and opposition teams.
 - In particular, any type of behaviour that demeans or offends another person on the basis of that person's race, colour or religion will not be tolerated.
 - Encourage your children to play by the Netball Victoria Bylaws.
 - Condemn the use of violence in all forms.
 - Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse.
 - Encourage the principle that honest effort is just as important as winning.
 - Do not engage in sledging. It will not be tolerated by Eltham Panthers Netball Club under any circumstances.
 - Do not undermine the efforts of our Coaches or Officials or Representatives and recognise and acknowledge the value and contribution made by these volunteers.
 - If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the official's judgement and honesty in public.
 - Assist with match day and training tasks wherever possible.
 - Encourage other persons to follow these principles.
