



PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be a responsible role model.
 - Be early for training and games.
 - If you can't train or play, advise your Coach and /or your Team Manager as soon as you are aware you cannot attend.
 - Show respect to your teammates, coaches, officials and opposition.
 - Treat your teammates, as you would like to be treated yourself.
 - Do not participate in any type of aggressive behaviour, both physical and verbal, to umpires, officials, players or any other club members and opposition teams.
 - In particular, any type of behaviour that demeans or offends another person on the basis of that person's race, colour or religion will not be tolerated.
 - Control your temper and do not use bad language.
 - Become aware of and play by the Netball Victoria and Manningham Association Bylaws.
 - Read and understand the Eltham Panthers Netball Club's policies and become aware of and abide by them.
 - Never argue with an Umpire's decision.
 - Always attempt to follow your coach's instructions at games or training and try your hardest.
 - Be a good sport.
 - Make every effort to shake your opponent's hand before and after every match.
 - Be humble in victory and gracious in defeat.
